Conversion of SRO in Four-Story Brownstone: 1537 Pacific St

Located in Crown Heights,
Brooklyn, this once stately
Brownstone had fallen into major
disrepair from years of neglect
suffered while being used as an
SRO. Once a hodgepodge of
rooms, this four-story structure was
gutted down to its frame and
reconfigured to house 3
apartments containing a total of 7
bedrooms, 7 bathrooms, 3
kitchens, and a finished cellar.
Upon completion, the property was
resold its first week on the market
for more than four-times its initial
purchase price.

















Hempstead Single-Family Remodel: 106 Elizabeth Avenue (Hempstead, NY)

A complete makeover was given to this home that had been vacant for some time, and was at one point occupied by squatters. We outfitted the residence with the following new features: roof, siding, windows, HVAC, heating, plumbing, electrical systems, wood flooring, tile work in bathrooms and kitchen, and in-ceiling speakers. Upon completion of construction, the property was in contract to be sold less than 30 days on the market.





Full Rehab With Vertical and Horizontal Extension and C/O Change 221-06 133rd Street (Laurelton, Queens)

Urban Ecospaces completed a vertical and horizontal extension on this residence with a Certificate of Occupancy change. The existing home was completely gutted. The extended floor plan on the first floor allowed for the creation of an entirely new open floorplan kitchen. This residence was updated with the following new features: roof, siding, windows, HVAC, heating, plumbing, electrical systems, wood flooring, tile work, new kitchen and bathrooms, and a finished basement.





















Gut Renovation of Hoarder's House 105-19 192nd Street (St. Alban's Queens)

Our principal acquired this development project via a guardianship sale. The prior owner was a hoarder, and there was debris from floor to ceiling in most rooms of the house. Prior to construction four 40 -

yard containers were required to remove all of the remaining garbage. The home was in utter disrepair and received a complete makeover with all new roof, siding, windows, HVAC, heating, plumbing, electrical systems, and wood flooring. Additionally, the basement and attic were finished.
